



Vacancy: Terrestrial Ranger – Land Restoration Project

Overview

Sint Eustatius National Parks Foundation (STENAPA) is seeking a dedicated and enthusiastic Ranger to contribute to our Land Restoration initiatives. This role is integral to implementing strategies for invasive species management and habitat restoration, reinforcing STENAPA's commitment to safeguarding natural ecosystems. Reporting to the Terrestrial Parks Manager and the Invasive Species Officer and Land Restoration Project Coordinator, the Ranger will play a vital role as part of the National Parks Foundation Terrestrial Team.

Key Responsibilities

- Support the construction and maintenance of fencing to protect restoration sites.
- Assist with biodiversity and invasive species monitoring activities, including data collection.
- Contribute to invasive species control measures and evaluate their effectiveness.
- Maintain tools, equipment, and monitoring systems essential for project operations.
- Assist in planting and habitat restoration efforts.
- Support other STENAPA projects and activities, including guided hikes, ReforeStatia, Botanical Garden, volunteer coordination, and general park maintenance.

Personal Specification and Qualifications

- Relevant experience in ecological fieldwork, fencing, or habitat restoration.
- Knowledge of or willingness to learn about invasive species and local ecosystems.
- Physically fit and capable of working outdoors in various weather conditions.
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team.
- Driver's license.
- Proficiency in basic IT tools, including data collection applications.

- Knowledge of Caribbean flora and fauna.
- Skills in carpentry, equipment repair, or other technical fields beneficial to habitat restoration.
